1. Targets two or more parallel concept names (distinct category or class of persons, things, events, objects) or examples of a concept.	2 1 0	
Overall Concept:		
1. Is the name of a larger group that contains the targeted concept.	✓ 1 0	
2. Provides a meaningful description of the overall category rather than a repetition (e.g., if the concept is "science standards" then the overall category should be more meaningful than simply "standard").	✓ 1 0	
Characteristics:		
1. Provides all of the "always" characteristics for each concept/example	✓ 1 0	
2. If the characteristics are the same, they are presented in the same way.	✓ 1 0	
3. Are recorded in a parallel manner (all sentences or all phrases). If presented as phrases, the phrase makes a complete sentence when the name of the concept or example is used as the subject.	2
