SeeSaw is a fully-online, interactive classroom application that allows teachers to prepare and administer lessons for any grade level or subject area. Additionally, users can search content by specific state standards. SeeSaw works well with Clever & Google Classroom. In Clever, districts can add a SeeSaw button so students remain logged in and can find the program easily. It is accessible to all students in the classroom and at home, assuming the school is 1:1. The program offers unique lesson planning/prep for remote learning and teacher resources, including many free activities for grades K-12.

For contextual requirements this app is very versatile. Not only can it be used in schools that are 1:1 or have classroom carts of laptops, but most lessons can be converted into a Google Doc and printed out. Classrooms would only need access to a printer and writing utensils. Because it's a free resource all teachers can use it regardless of department budgets, and it is compatible with many different programs so all schools can use it regardless of the district's choice of technology.. The program is compatible with Chromebooks, computers, iPads, iPhones, Android tablets, Android phones, and Kindle Fire.
